1. In a decision dated 15 September 2016, the Tribunal found that a charge of serious misconduct against the respondent was made out, and orders were made as to penalty and costs. The respondent was ordered to pay 40% of the costs of the hearing (Tribunal and CAC costs). The Tribunal delegated to the Chairperson the authority to specify the amount to be paid upon receipt of the respondent's submissions about the schedules of costs submitted.
2. The Secretary and CAC were invited to file schedules of costs, and the respondent could then make submissions.
3. The CAC submitted costs totalled \$5,094.94, and for the Tribunal, the Secretary submitted a schedule of \$990.
4. The respondent did not wish to be heard.
5. Accordingly, I order that the respondent pays \$2,430.98, comprising \$2,037.98 under s404(1)(h) and \$396 under s404(1)(i) of the Education Act 1989.
