DECISION OF TRIBUNAL ON COSTS

1. This matter was heard on the papers. The parties agreed that the respondent should pay 50% of the costs of the CAC.
2. In a decision dated 14 November 2016, the Tribunal ordered the respondent to pay 50% of the costs of conducting the hearing, under section 404(1)(h) and (i), that is 50% of the Tribunal's costs and 50% of the CAC's actual and reasonable costs. The Tribunal delegated to the Chairperson authority to determine the quantum of those costs.
3. The CAC has filed a schedule of costs totalling \$9,033.34.
4. The Secretary of the Tribunal has filed a schedule of costs totalling \$1,146.
5. I therefore direct that the respondent pay costs:
 - a. Under s 404(1)(h) the sum of \$4,516.67, being 50% of the CAC costs
 - b. Under s 404(1)(i) the sum of \$573, being 50% of the Tribunal costs.
