COSTS DECISION

1. In a decision dated 16 May 2017, the Tribunal found that a charge of serious misconduct against the respondent was made out, and orders were made as to penalty and costs. The respondent was ordered to pay 40% of the costs of conducting the hearing, under section 404(1)(h) and (i), that is 40% of the Tribunal's costs and 40% of the CAC's actual and reasonable costs.
2. The CAC submitted and served a schedule of costs totalling \$6,389.34, and for the Tribunal, the Secretary submitted a schedule of \$2,735.
3. The respondent filed no response.
4. The Tribunal has considered the costs and orders that the respondent pays \$3649.74, comprising \$2,555.74 under s404(1)(h) and \$1,094 under s404(1)(i) of the Education Act 1989.
